If you are using a Nook HD/HD+, NOOK Tablet or NOOK Color, go to the NOOK app store and download the free OverDrive Media Console App to your NOOK. This app will allow you to download library ebooks directly to your NOOK. Instructions for installing the app on an Android device are available here: <http://myhelp.overdrive.com/MyHelpMH20>.

For all other NOOKs, you must use a program called Adobe Digital Editions to transfer library eBooks from your computer to your NOOK. Be sure to install this software before trying to download any library eBooks (instructions for downloading Adobe Digital Editions can be found at the end of this document).

3. Next, either *Add to Digital Cart* (be sure to select the correct format – only ePub and PDF are NOOK compatible). If the book you want is checked out, you may *Place a Hold*.

5. Type in your library card number, then select *Log In*.

6. The *Digital Media – Check Out* screen will appear. Choose your lending period (7, 14, or 21 days), then select *Confirm Check Out*.

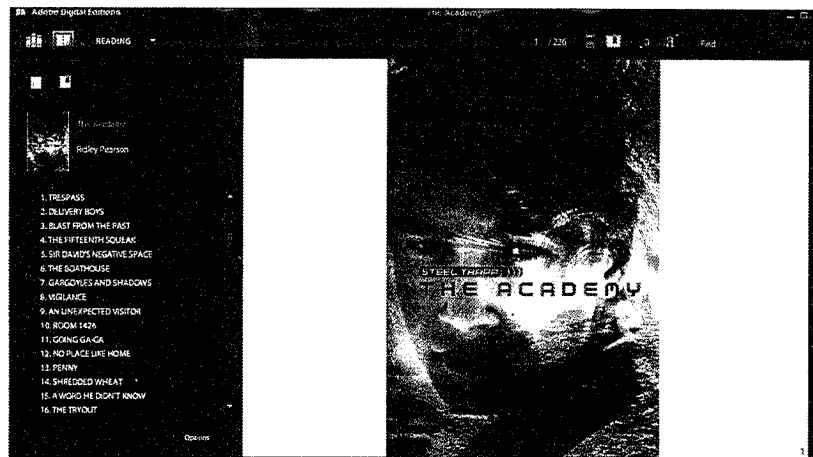

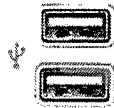

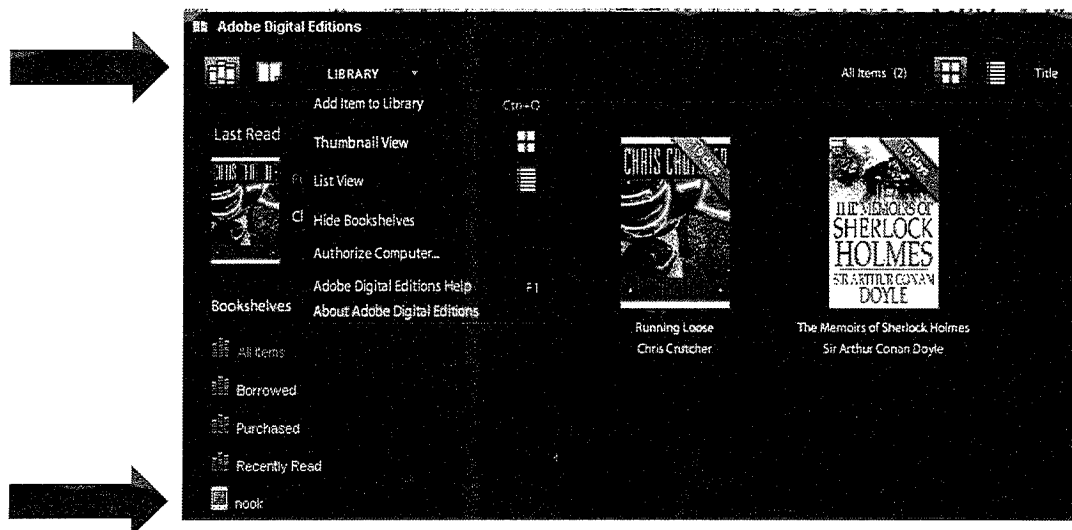
8. Once your eBook has downloaded to your computer, it will automatically open up in Adobe Digital Editions. The screen should look something like this.



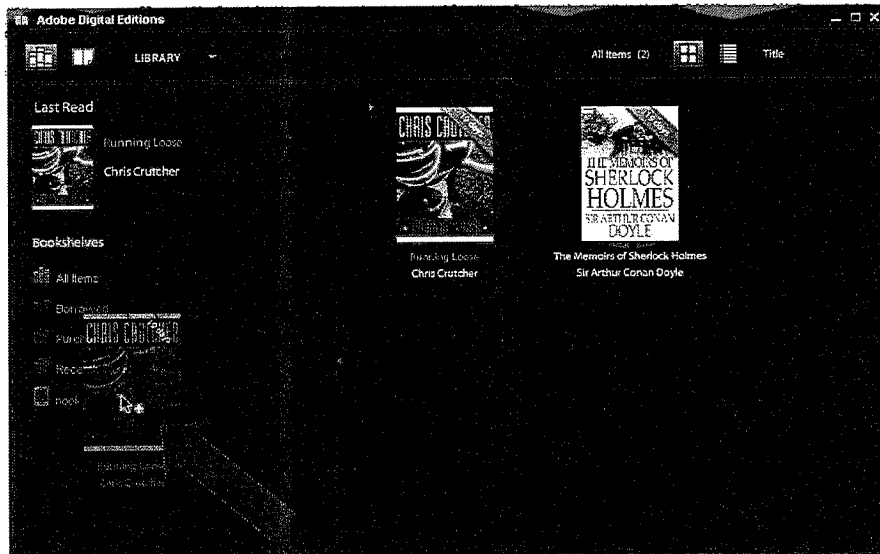
9. Connect your NOOK to your computer using the USB port and the USB cable that came with your NOOK.



10. Click on the Library View tab in the upper left hand corner. If your NOOK has been properly connected and activated, it will appear as an icon in the lower left corner of Adobe Digital Editions. It will be called either *NOOK* or *Media*.



11. Left click on the book you want to upload to your NOOK (on the right side of the screen) and drag the book to the NOOK icon (on the left side of the screen) until the NOOK is highlighted and a green plus sign (+) appears in the highlighted NOOK section. Release the mouse and the book will begin uploading to the NOOK (this may take several minutes.)



12. When your book has finished uploading, safely disconnect your NOOK before unplugging it from your computer.

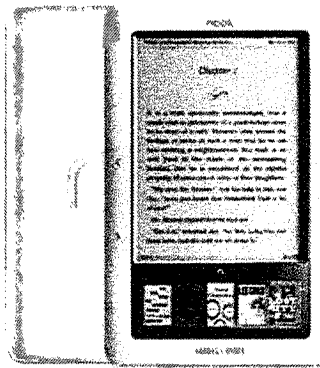

NOOK – First Generation

13. At the bottom of your NOOK (the touch screen part) touch *my library*.



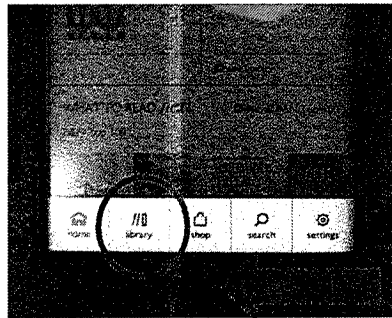
14. Your documents will appear in the top part of the NOOK.



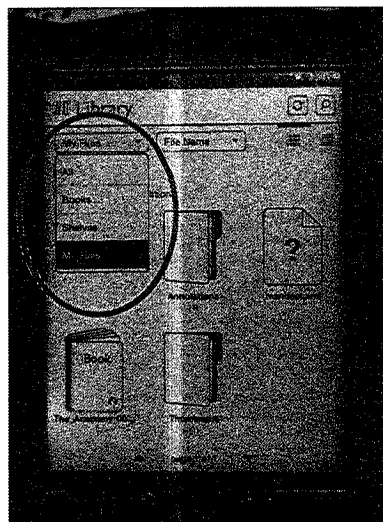
15. Touching the arrow keys will enable you to scroll through all the titles on your NOOK. Highlight the book that you want to read (there will be lines above and below the title) and touch the button with the circle (o) in the center (last button on the right side of the touch screen.)

NOOK Simple Touch

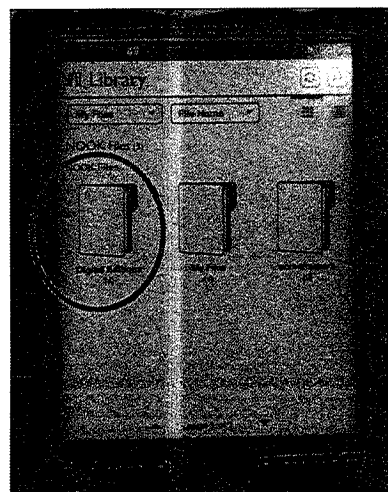
16. Touch the *Menu* button, located at the bottom of the NOOK screen, then touch *library*, the second icon from the left.



17. In the *library* folder, touch *My Files* in the upper left corner.




18. Select the *Digital Editions* folder and touch the book you would like to open.



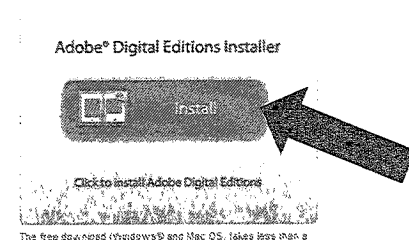
Downloading Adobe Digital Editions

1. Download the Adobe Digital Editions software found at <http://www.adobe.com/products/digitaleditions/> to your computer
2. Next, click *Download Now*.




Adobe® Digital Editions software offers an engaging way to view and manage eBooks and other digital publications. Use it to download and purchase digital content, which can be read both online and offline. Transfer copy-protected eBooks from your personal computer

3. Click *Install*.



4. Once Adobe is done installing follow the instructions on the setup. Once completed, Adobe Digital Editions will open automatically. You will be asked to either create an Adobe account or type in your username and password.



Digital Editions makes it easy to transfer protected eBooks between multiple computers and mobile devices. To enable these features, you need to authorize each of your machines with your Adobe ID. [More info](#)

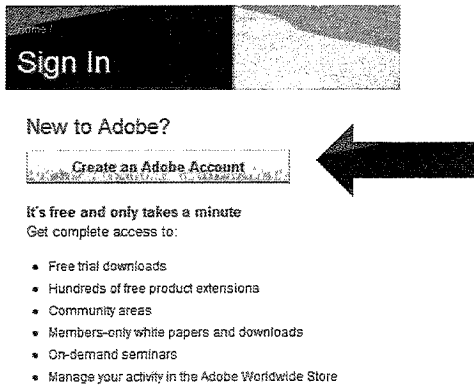
Don't Authorize Computer

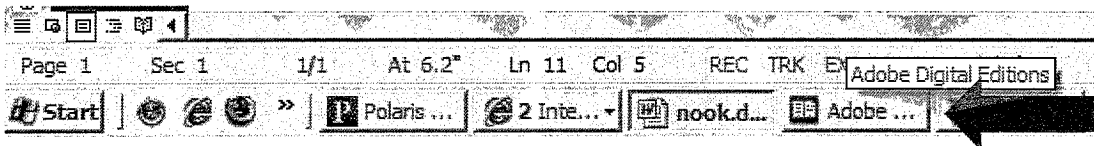

5. If you do not have an Adobe account, click *Get an Adobe ID Online*. If you do have an account, skip to step 8.

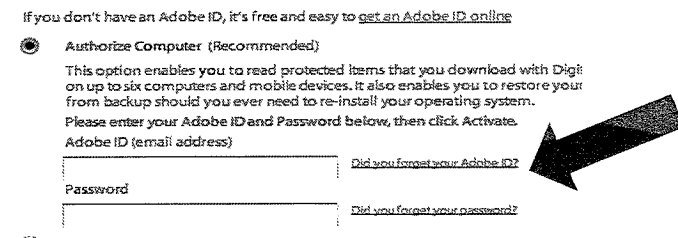
6. Click on *Create an Adobe Account* and follow the instructions.



7. On the bottom of computer screen click on the *Adobe Digital Editions* tab.



8. Type in your Adobe ID (your email address) and your password and click *Activate* and then *Finish*.



9. Once this screen appears, you are ready to download your eBook to the computer.
